



MAKE WOMA. MAKE FRIEND.

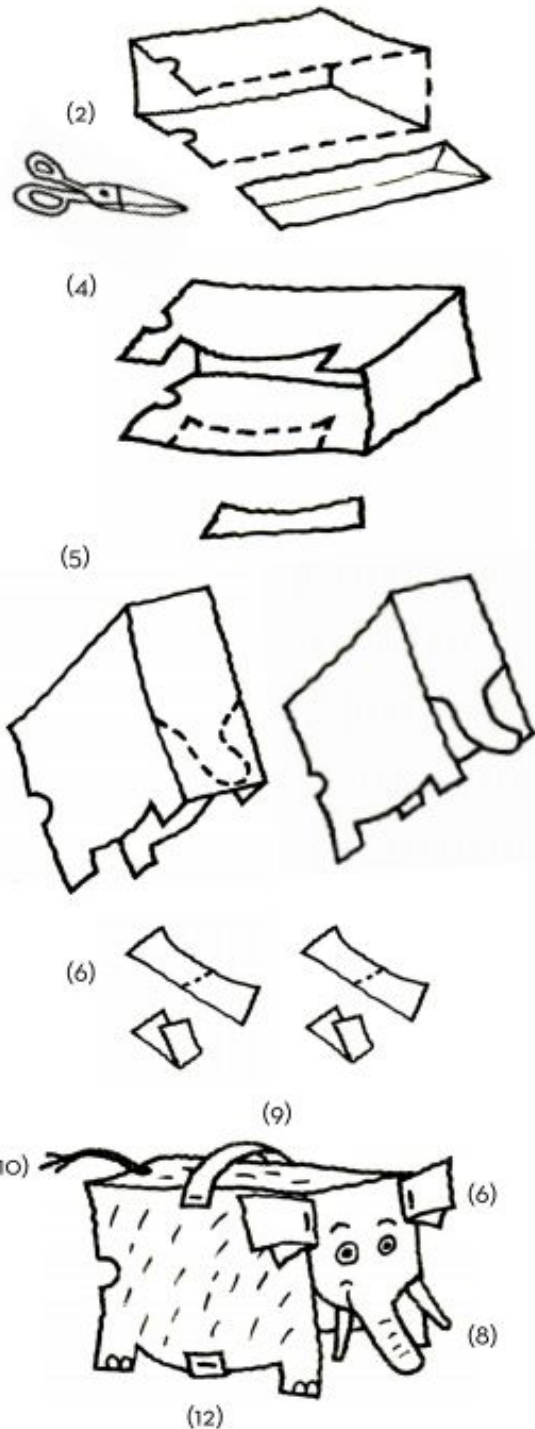
Create your own woolly mammoth for friendship and occasional protection against saber-toothed creatures.

What You Will Need:

- Brown paper grocery bag (with or without handles)
- Black or brown crayon or marker
- Scissors & stapler

What You Might Do:

- 1) Remove any handles from the grocery bag. Keep the handles!
- 2) Cut out one narrow side of the bag.
- 3) If bag has writing on it, gently turn it inside-out.
- 4) Make mammoth feet & a belly by cutting into the edge of the longer side of the bag. Repeat on the opposite side. Keep the paper scraps!
- 5) Draw and cut out a mammoth trunk on the bottom of the bag.
- 6) To create ears, fold the feet/belly paper scraps off-center and staple to the side of your mammoth's head.
- 7) Draw eyes, eyebrows, and a mammoth smile above the trunk!
- 8) Cut out the tusks from the next page and staple them on either side of the trunk.
- 9) Cut out the handle from the next page, fold it in half, and staple it to the top of the mammoth (writing side up).
- 10) Cut a mammoth tail from a bag handle or paper scrap. Snip the end for a tufted tail!
- 11) Cover your mammoth with fur with a marker or crayon. Hopefully your Woma will not shed!
- 12) Use another bag handle or paper scrap and the stapler to connect and brace the two sides of your mammoth's belly. Now take your Woma for a walk!

Woma Handle

Cut around the outside edge of the Woma Handle, fold in the center, and attach to the top of your woolly mammoth with staples for easy Woma walking.

Woma Tusk

Cut out the tusks and attach to either side of Woma's trunk.
